With its enchanting underwater scenery, one of the healthiest marine animal cultures in the Caribbean and superior amenities, Curaçao invites you to dive deep into a sea of wonder.

The Dive Task Force, which forms part of the Curaçao Hospitality and Tourism Association (CHATA), is comprised of dive schools that are approved by the Curaçao Tourist Board and monitored for their quality, safety and sustainability.

6. PUTTING CONSERVATION FIRST

7. AN INCREDIBLE WRECK DIVE

The Superior Producer, a coastal cargo ship, sunk in 1977 en route from Isla Margarita and settled some 196 feet from the coast of Curaçao, where it now lies veiled in corals and sponges.

8. EASY TO TRAVEL TO

Curaçao is located in the Dutch Caribbean outside the hurricane belt. Average water temperatures of 82°F and frequent direct flights make it a year-round diver's heaven.

9. SO MUCH TO SEE

Curaçao's waters boast countless species of marine life, including spiny lobsters, parrotfish, angelfish, turtles, scorpionfish and moray eels. Embark on a magical night dive to admire anemones, octopuses and spider crabs.
